### INSTRUCTIONS FOR ABSTRACTS AND/OR SIGNIFICANT EXPERIENCES’S SUBMISSION

Abstracts and significant experiences submission for II INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE: EDUCATION AND SOCIAL MOBILITY “GLOBAL CHALLENGE, RESPONSABILITY OF ALL” should follow the guidelines explained below and must be uploaded through the link <http://bit.ly/forointernacionaleyms> from May 1 until June 30, 2018. The acceptance of the

abstracts and/or significant experiences' will be informed to the authors by July 15. Check the website <http://unisimon.edu.co/servicios/simposioem>

### **MAXIMUM LENGTH**

The word counter of the Word program should indicate a maximum of 5,000 words, including: summary, sections, graphs, tables, references / bibliography, annexes and abstract authors' abstract.

### **FORMAT**

- ❖ Font type: Times New Roman, size 12.
- ❖ Space between lines: 1.5
- ❖ Use Microsoft Word 2010 or higher to maximize compatibility.

### **STRUCTURE**

- ❖ Title. It must be written in English and Spanish.
- ❖ Author (S): In addition to the names of the authors, put a footnote for each author that indicates, in order, the last level of formation, position and institutional linkage, country and email.
- ❖ Thematic issue/track. Indicate the axis to which your paper is applying
- ❖ Theme inside the thematic axis. Indicate the specific topic within the axis.
- ❖ Summary: must be written in Spanish and English (abstract). Maximum 200 words.
- ❖ Keywords: They must be written in Spanish and English (key words). Minimum five words.

### **DOCUMENT BODY**

This is the structure that all documents presented must have

- ❖ Introduction
- ❖ Theoretical foundation
- ❖ Methodology.
- ❖ Results
- ❖ Conclusions and discussion
- ❖ References. In addition to the documents relevant to the subject, it must contain updated references of ISI journals, SCOPUS, or other recognized Databases, in order to show the articulation of their research to the debates of the international academic community. Minimum of 16 references.

This list should sort each document alphabetically by the author's last name, or name of the entity and the presentation changes depending on the type of document (Review APA Standards, 6 edition).
